
1. Map

Visual representation of routes that you can navigate with your pet with an included satellite view. Each Pawfit pet has their own status card which indicates battery life as well as GPS signal. Each function such as Live Tracking, Sound and Light have a ten-minute countdown in order to preserve battery.

Location: Share your live location with friends in your pet's family. **Select +** to choose the pet you would like to add friends to.


Status Card:

Each Pawfit pet has their own status card which indicates battery life, GPS signal and live updates of location in real time. You can minimise status card to half the size - simply tap your pet's avatar and select again to return to original size.



Choose:

Individually select which pet you are walking or select 'All pets' --->





Live Tracking: Once enabled, the tracker refreshes your pet's location every 5 seconds as well as enforcing the GPS module to stay active for 10 minutes. This mode provides the most frequent and accurate update of your pet's location.

Sound: Useful alarm sound with a tenminute time frame to locate pet as well as voice control option. Simply select 'Add' to record your own voice commands.

Light: Tap to turn on the LED light which flashes green to locate your pet in the dark – this feature also has a ten-minute time frame.

Location: Centre your location on the map.

View: Tap for either street view or satellite view.

2. Activity

Each pet has their own activity log page that includes the day, week and month and logs all exercise related data such as step count.

Activity: Your pet's activity will be logged on this page. It calculates step count, active hours, rest hours and calories burnt.


Share: Share your pet's activity with family and friends or to social media platforms.

Date: Select the date of your trip or look at our previous trip history.

Share: Share your pet's trip duration with friends and family or to social media platforms.

3. Trip: Slider This page includes a slider that indicates GPS strength at different stages of the trip with a time stamp. It also represents the start, duration and end of the trip.

View: Select this feature to view route with/without paw prints.


View: Tap for either street view or satellite view.

4. Walk

Each pet has their live walk tracked that displays real time duration, average speed and total distance covered which can also be shared live with family and friends.

Invite: Live share with your friends and family so they can also track your walk with your pet.

Start: Start/Stop your trip and once completed – a walk report will be generated that will cover total steps and average speed which can also be shared with friends/family.

Contacts: Tap to add a new Pawfit friend or enter name to search for an existing friend.

History: Look back on previous walks by looking at the list of walk reports generated for you.


Log: Log your pet's activity such as stopping to eat/drink throughout the walk.

Photo: Take photos of you and your pet along your trip by taking a live photo or uploading from gallery.

5. Profile

Each Pawfit is complete with a pet profile where you can edit your pet's information or add an additional pet. Select 'Add pet', enter their information and enter the device ID to complete their profile.


Messages: Check your messages that you will receive such as your pet's activity achievements and low battery alerts. **Scan:** Align the two-dimensional ID code of your family or friends' pet to scan and add as a Pawfit friend.







User Profile: Your user profile is where you can update your information, view and manage your subscription, access your Pawfit ID and QR code as well user settings.




Information: Edit and update your user information such as change of address.

QR Code: Your family members or friends can scan this QR code using the Pawfit camera to add you to their contacts.

Settings: Check your settings such as language settings, push notification settings and map settings.

About Pawfit: Check Pawfit's terms of use and our privacy policies as well as FAQ'S and our contact information.

Pawfit Subscription: Check your Pawfit subscription status and review the option to renew if it is expired.



Pet advanced settings: Simply go to Profile > Select your pet > Advanced settings.

Home WiFi: Select your home WiFi so that once your pet is at home, the GPS will disable so that battery life is preserved.

Device ID: Scan the QR code printed on the back of the device to retrieve the 8-character ID. This is your Tracker ID.

Safety Zone: Safety zones act as virtual fences. Select + to add a zone to your safety zone list. In live tracking mode, you can expect to receive an alert when your dog crosses the border of any of the safety zones, as it updates the location every 5 seconds.

Pawfit Voice: Add your own voice commands such as calling your pet's name – the Pawfit allows up to 5 voice commands.

Power saving mode:

When this mode is enabled, it saves battery by reducing the location update frequency during passive tracking.
